## 1. THE FAMILY

- Let the school know about any concerns or problems that might affect my child's work or behaviour.
- Support the school's policies and guidelines including those relating to behaviour and attendance.
- Support my child and the school with Homework.
- Attend Parent's Evenings and any discussions about my child's progress.
- Get to know about my child's life at the school and become involved in the school community where possible, for example by attending family forum workshops, curriculum events and whole school events.

- Care for your child's well being and happiness.
- Ensure that your child achieves his/her full potential as a valued member of the school community.
- Ensure that children achieve high standards of work and behaviour.
- Provide regular information on the curriculum of your child.
- Contact parents if there is a problem with attendance, punctuality or equipment. The school reserves the right to request proof of appointments to allow us to monitor attendance without prejudice, and to authorise absence.
- Let parents know about any concerns and problems that affect their child's work, behaviour or well being.
- Set, mark and monitor Homework and celebrate successes on our website
- Arrange regular Parent's Evenings during which progress will be discussed.
- Keep Parents informed about school activities through regular letters home, home/school books if appropriate or requested, Newsletters and notices about special events.
