Music: Arabian music - creating an atmosphere

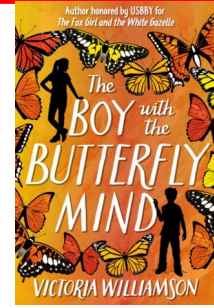
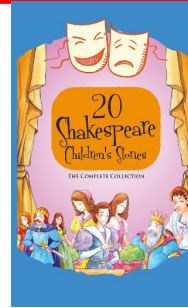
French: The Very Hungry Caterpillar
