
YEAR 3 PARENT NEWSLETTER: SUMMER 2

Reminders

Please be aware that the heat within the classrooms is steadily increasing. For this reason, it is vital that your child comes into school with a water bottle.

<u>Online safety</u>

Please make sure that you are continuing to support your child's online safety by ensuring you are aware of the content that they are consuming online. If you have any questions about how to keep your child safe, please talk to their class teacher.

We have had a number of children who are accessing inappropriate and often frightening content on YouTube. Children in Year 3 should be restricted to the You Tube kids website rather than the standard site. Some of the children are aloso playing games with an age rating well above their actual age. Video games rated 12, 15 and 18 are not suitable for children in Year 3.

It is vital that you keep your child safe by ensuring their devices are restricted to content for their age, either through parental controls on these devices or by using parental control software.
