Outdoor PE: Cross Country

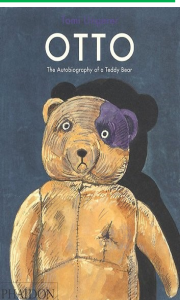
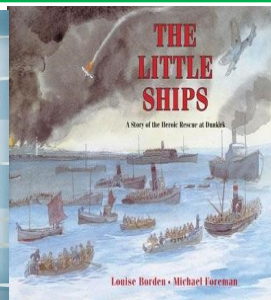
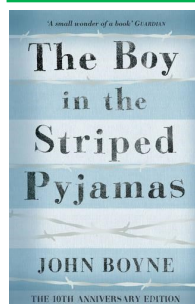
French: Ou habites-tu?
