Macbeth workshop- Wednesday 23rd April

This workshop will take place in school during school hours. As part of our Great Minds topic, which will begin in the summer term, your child will have the opportunity to participate in an amazing workshop run by Bigfoot Arts Education. Each class will discover Shakespeare's tragic story of Macbeth through drama. They will practise using a range of dramatic techniques and explore Shakespearean language which they can then apply within their own writing later in the term.
